# **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR HORTI 2 LN LUMINAIRES**

## **Operating temperature range:**

HORTI 2 LN: +5°C... +40°C


The light source used in the HORTI 2 LN luminaire should only be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person. The manufacturer does not provide: screws, wall plugs, slings, carabiners, etc.

### Installation

- a) Remove the luminaire from the packaging
- b) Prepare a rope or chain sling\* with a carabiner hook (1)
- c) Clip the carabiner into the handle (2)
- d) Connect the power 230 V AC / 50 Hz:

Connect the power cord (3x0,5mm2 - 3x2,5mm2) to the mains 230 V AC / 50 Hz (3)





#### **Final Provisions:**

connection of the luminaires to the network may only be performed by persons with appropriate authorizations
the manufacturer does not recommend and is not responsible for defects resulting from any activities inside the luminaire
the manufacturer is not liable for defects resulting from non-compliance with the recommendations of this manual
the manufacturer reserves the right to change the design of the product

·\*the slings used should be solid and resistant to stretching.

Slings, links and chains should have a load capacity of at least five times the weight of the luminaire •ATTENTION! Do not stare into the light beam of the LED(s).

·Warning, risk of electric shock.

ATTENTION! Failure to connect the PE wire may cause electric shock
